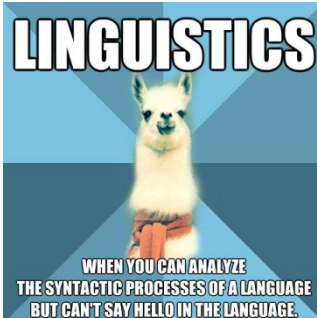

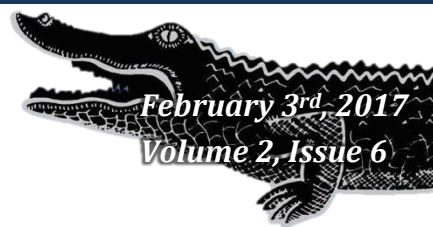
## Syntax Reading Group
